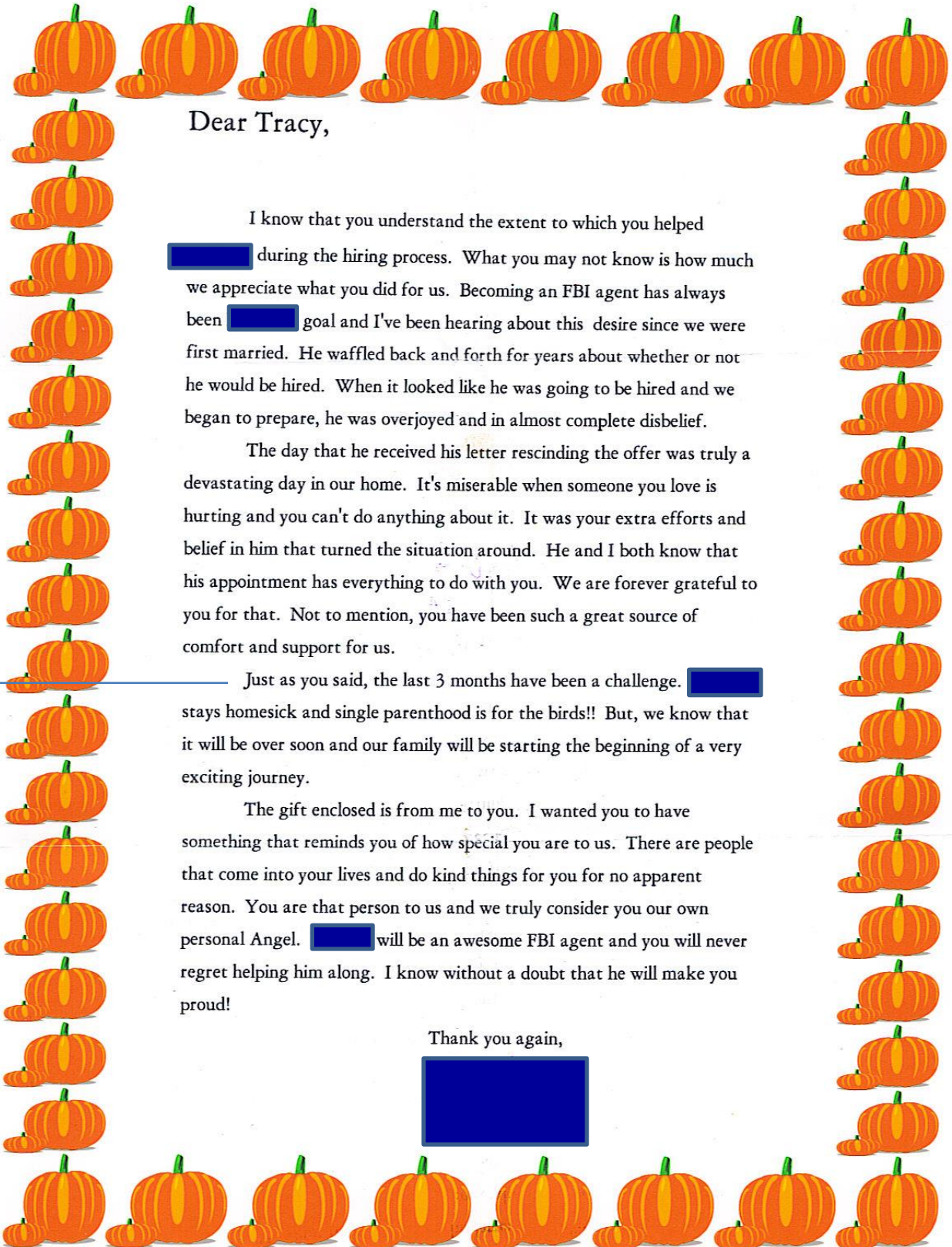

Dear Tracy,

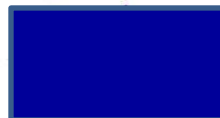
